At least two years of experience as a litigator or appellate court clerk is strongly preferred.

Qualifications: Strong academic credentials, excellent research, writing, and analytical skills, and the ability to work efficiently and manage a large work load. Must be an active member of the State Bar of Georgia or another State Bar and will be admitted to the State Bar of Georgia within one year of employment. Previous law clerk or staff attorney experience preferred.
